CHARACTERISTICS OF THE NEW VATU FAMILY SERIES OF COINS.

By virtue of Section 19 (2) of the Reserve Bank Act Cap. 125, the Reserve Bank hereby publishes the characteristics of the following denominations of the new Vatu family series of coins:

Denomination: VT5 Coin

Size: 19.0mm

Weight: 2.82gm

Shape: Round

Metal Content: Copper Plated Steel (CPS)

Edging: Plain

Obverse: The main design features on the front are the National Coat of Arms, Year of Mintage.

Reverse: Designs on the back feature an Outrigger Canoe symbolizing the role of the canoe in inter-island trading. The main design is featured against a background design of traditional patterns.

Theme: 'Interisland Trading' as depicted by the design feature on the reverse side of the coin.

Denomination: VT10 Coin

Size: 21.0mm

Weight: 3.64gm

Shape: Round

Metal Content: Nickel Plated Steel (NPS)

Edging: Plain

Obverse: The main design features on the front are the National Coat of Arms, Year of Mintage.

Reverse: Designs on the back feature the Coconut crab highlighting the need for conservation of this endangered wildlife which is also a delicacy. The main design is featured against a background design of traditional patterns.

Theme: 'Endangered Wildlife' as depicted by the design features on the reverse side of the coin.

Denomination: VT20 Coin

Size: 24.2mm

Weight: 5.47gm

Shape: Round

Metal Content: Nickel Plated Steel (NPS)

Edging: Milled

Obverse: The main design features on the front are the National Coat of Arms, Year of Mintage.

Reverse: Designs on the back feature a Traditional meeting which pays tribute to the role of traditional and community leaders or *jifs*. The main design is featured against a background design of traditional patterns.

Theme: 'Traditional Governance' as depicted by the design features on the reverse side of the coin.

Denomination: VT50 Coin

Size: 27.0mm

Weight: 9.19gm

Shape: Round

Metal Content: Nickel Plated Steel (NPS)

Edging: Milled

Obverse: The main design features on the front are the National Coat of Arms, Year of Mintage.

Reverse: Designs on the back feature the *Kava* plant and *Navara* representing coconut and copra. The designs highlight two of Vanuatu's economic mainstays against a background design of traditional patterns.

Theme: 'Economic Mainstays' as depicted by the design features on the reverse side of the coin.

Denomination: VT100 Coin

Size: 23.25mm

Weight: 6.84gm

Shape: Scalloped

Metal Content: Aluminium Zinc Bronze (Al-Zn-Br)

Edging: Plain

- Obverse: The main design features on the front are the National Coat of Arms, Year of Mintage.
- Reverse: Designs on the back feature the Parliament House symbolizing Modern Governance and the rule of law. The main design is featured against a background design of traditional patterns.
- Theme: 'Modern Governance' as depicted by the design features on the reverse side of the coin.
