1. Short title	2. Increase in salary of Controller and Chief Auditor

AN ACT to amend the Audit Office Ordinance 1961.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Assembly of Western Samoa in Parliament assembled as follows:—

[23 August 1976]

1. Short title—This Act may be cited as the Audit Office Amendment Act 1976, and shall be read together with and be deemed part of the Audit Office Ordinance 1961* (hereinafter referred to as the Ordinance).

2. Increase in salary of Controller and Chief Auditor—(1) Section 9 of the Ordinance is amended by repealing subsection (1) (as amended by section 2 of the Audit Office Act 1974**), and substituting the following subsection:—

“(1) There shall be paid to the Controller and Chief Auditor out of the Treasury Fund, without further appropriation than this section, —

- (a) In the case of a Controller and Chief Auditor recruited in Western Samoa, a salary, with effect from the 1st day of January 1976, of 7,000 tālā per annum, without annual increments or allowances;
- (b) In the case of a Controller and Chief Auditor recruited from overseas, a salary, with effect from the 1st

day of January 1976, of 6,770 tālā per annum for the first year, thereafter rising by annual increments of 115 tālā each to a maximum of 7,000 tālā per annum, together with such allowances, rights and privileges as are normally payable by the Public Service Commission to overseas or seconded officers in the Western Samoa Public Service."

(2) The Audit Office Amendment Act 1974 is consequentially repealed.
