## AN ORDINANCE

made by the Administrator of the Territory of Vestern Samoa with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of that Territory, and in

 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Cocoa Beans Sales Ordinance, 1931," and shall come into force on the first day of January, 1932.
 When a sale of cocoabeans takes place, the phechaser and the vendor shall make a record of the same in the form set outly the schedule hereto, and the purchaser shall produce such record on dequand at any time within two years of the date of such sale to any inspector of produce appointed by the Administrator.

3. (a) No person shall sell or offer or expose for sale or tender in satisfaction of any demand any cocoa pods or cocoabeans which have

not been thoroughly dried.

(b) This section shall have no force or effect with regard to cocoa

pods or cocoabeans sold and used for seed parposes.

4. Any person who commits procures or encourages any person to commit any breach of any of the provisions of this Ordinance or who makes any record in the form set out in the schedule hereto which is false or misleading shall be liable to a fine not exceeding twenty five pounds.

5. The Administrator may make regulations for all or any of the following purposes:

(1) Buying of "green" cocoa and issuing licenses for same;

(2) Appointing of officers for any purpose in connection with this Ordinance;

(3) Prescribing fees to be paid for any matter or thing done under this Ordinance or any of its regulations.
