**AN ACT to amend the Judicature Ordinance 1961 to provide for an increase to the salaries of Judges.**

*[10 February 1984]*

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Legislative Assembly of Western Samoa in Parliament assembled as follows:—

**1. Short title**— This Act may be cited as the Judicature Amendment Act 1983.

**2. Principal Act**— The Judicature Ordinance 1961\* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**3. Salaries of Judges**— Section 29 of the Principal Act is repealed and replaced by the following section:—

“29. There shall be charged on the Treasury Fund and paid as statutory expenditure—

(a) to the Chief Justice,—

(i) with effect from 1 January 1983, a salary at the rate of \$46,300 a year; and

(ii) with effect from 1 January 1984, a salary at the rate of \$53,080 a year; and

(b) to each other Judge of the Supreme Court, with effect from 1 January 1984, a salary of \$50,440 a year”.
