1991, No. 7

AN ACT to amend the Public Money Act 1964.

[23 July 1991]

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Assembly of Western Samoa in Parliament assembled as follows:-

1. Short title—This Act may be cited as the Public Money Amendment Act 1991 and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Public Money Act 1964 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Deputy Financial Secretaries—Sections 6 of the principal Act is amended by

(a) repealing the heading thereto and substituting as a heading the words “Deputy Financial Secretaries”;

(b) omitting from subsection (1) the words “an officer” and substituting the word “officer”;

(c) omitting from subsection (1) the words “a Deputy Financial Secretary” and substituting the words “Deputy Financial Secretary”;

(d) omitting from subsection (2) the words “Deputy Financial Secretary” and substituting the words “Such Deputy Financial Secretary as may be appointed by the Financial Secretary.”

(e) omitting from subsection (3) the words “the Deputy”, and substituting the words “a Deputy”;
