THE SURVEYORS ORDINANCE, 1921.

AN ORDINANCE

Made by the Administrator of the Territory of Western Samoa with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of that Territory, and in pursuance of the Samoa Constitution Order, 1920.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Surveyors Ordinance 1921.
2. No person other than a surveyor licensed under the Surveyors' Institute and Board of Examiners Act 1908 of New Zealand in respect of a qualification or of a certificate and whose license is current shall without the consent of the Administrator practise as a surveyor in Samoa.
3. Any person who commits a breach of this Ordinance is liable to a fine not exceeding £20.
