AN ORDINANCE

made by the Administrator of the Territory of Western Samoa with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of that Territory, and in pursuance of the Samoa Act 1921.

Short Title.

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Talimatau Road Extension Closing Ordinance, 1934."
- In pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred by Section 347 of "The Samoa Act, 1921," and of all other powers and authorities thereto enabling the land mentioned and described in the Schedule hereto is hereby closed as a road.

THE SCHEDULE.

All that strip of land situated at Si'usega, near Apia, formerly known as the "Talimatau Road Extension," being parcel 200/134, Flur XI, Upolu, recorded in the Parcel Register of the Lands and Survey Department and shown on plans 1 U/XI S, 3 U/XI S, and 4 U/XI, S, lodged in the office of the Chief Surveyor at Apia and being portion of the road known as the "Talimatau Road Extension."

Assented to this sixth day of December 1934.
