AN ACT to amend the Western Samoa Trust Estates Corporation Act 1977 in order to provide that the appointed members of the Board of Directors shall hold office during the pleasure of the Head of State, acting on the advice of Cabinet.

[18 March 1986]

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Assembly of Western Samoa in Parliament assembled as follows:—

1. Short title—this Act may be cited as the Western Samoa Trust Estates Corporation Amendment Act 1986, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Western Samoa Trust Estates corporation Act 1977^a (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Application—This Act shall apply with respect to the term of office of every appointed director on the Board of Directors of the Corporation holding office on the coming into force of the Act.

3. Appointment of Directors—Section 5 of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing subsection (2), and substituting the following subsection:—

“(2) Every director shall hold office during the pleasure of the Head of state, acting on the advice of Cabinet.”

4. Extraordinary vacancies—Subsection (2) of the section 6 of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing the words “for disability, neglect of duty, or insolvency proved to the satisfaction of the Head of State, acting on the advice of Cabinet.”
