**REGULATIONS**

**1. Short title and commencement**-(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Public Service Amendment Regulations 2010 and shall be read with and form part of the Principal Regulations.

(2) These Regulations come into force on the date they are made.

**2. Interpretation** - In these Regulations, except where the context requires otherwise:

“Principal Regulations” means the Public Service Regulations 2008.

**3. Payment for untaken long service leave** - Regulation 16(3) of the Principal Regulations is repealed.

**4. Savings** - Any Application for approval under 16(3) made to the Commission before these Regulations come into force shall be dealt with by the Commission within the powers given it under that repealed regulation.
